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## **PART I: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS**

### **1.0 GENERAL**

Sambhar Salts Ltd. is a Subsidiary Company of Hindustan Salts Limited (A Govt. of India Enterprise) having its registered office at G-229, Sitapura Industrial Area, Jaipur-302022. Sambhar Salts Limited (hereafter referred as “Company” or “Sambhar Salts Limited”) is running a Nawa Salt Plant at Nawa, distt. Nagaur wherein 500 KVAR APFC Panel Board is required to be installed.

Accordingly Tenders are invited from eligible party for Supply, Installation and Commissioning of 500 KVAR Automatic Power Factor Control Panel along with all related equipment's. Tenders should be addressed to General Manager (Works), Sambhar Salts Limited, Sambhar Lake-303 604, Distt. Jaipur (Rajasthan)

### **2.0 ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

**Bidder shall meet the qualifying requirement stipulated hereunder:**

#### **2.1 General**

- (i) Manufacturer/ dealer are eligible. Valid certificate of the manufacturer/dealer must be attached.
- (ii) Manufacturer of critical components of the system viz. Capacitor banks, Automatic power factor controller and Vacuum capacitor switches for 500 KV APFC Panel. Valid certificate of the manufacturer/ dealer must be attached.
- (iii) The bidder has its own service centre available near Nawa.
- (iv) The bidder should have experience of execution of 500 KV APFC panel in Govt/PSUs/ Large industry. The certificate of the user in this regard shall also be enclosed.
- (v) The bidder should have its own valid HT Contractor License or should have to submit an agreement with the HT contractor who will execute the work on its behalf.
- (vi) The bidder shall not have been declared incompetent to participate in such type of bid.

#### **2.2 Financial Eligibility Criteria:**

The average annual turnover of the Bidder in the preceding three (3) financial years ending on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2018, shall not be less than INR 1,80,000 (Indian Rupees One Lakhs Eighty Thousand Only) or in equivalent foreign currency.

2.3 The “Start-ups” as defined in “Annexure-I” of “Action Plan for Start-ups in India” issued by Government of India are exempted from condition of Prior Experience (above Clause 2.2), subject to the condition that supply of material shall be ensured by such “Start-ups” as per the quality and technical specifications mentioned in tender documents.

2.4 Bidder shall quote the equipment having DCR component i.e. manufactured in India in pursuance of the Make in India initiative of Government of India.

2.5 Bidder shall submit, in support to the above, the list of equipment's commissioned along

with their work order/ LOI and the commissioning certificates evidence to be submitted along-with technical bid.

2.6 The bidder/ Company / Firm / Agency should be registered with the appropriate registration authority (Labour Commissioner, Income Tax Department, GST Department, Employees Provident Fund and Employees State Insurance Acts etc.)/ Or any other applicable laws for this purpose.

2.7 The bidder /Company / Firm / Agency should have its own Bank Account.

### **3. INSPECTION AT SITE BEFORE PRE-BID MEETING:**

Bidder may visit the site to get aware themselves about the site conditions before submission of offers.

### **4.0 OBLIGATIONS OF THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER/ CONTRACTOR:**

4.1 The Contractor should employ men/women aged between 18 to 58 yrs (preferably below 58), who have good health and clean conduct record.

4.2 The Contractor should employ personnel who can converse well in English and local language.

4.3 The Contractor should provide at least 2 sets of Uniforms to all personnel employed by them.

4.4 The Contractor should provide necessary tools and equipment's that are necessary for the performance of Contract.

### **5.0 SUBMISSION OF TENDER:**

**The tender should be submitted in two bid system as described below.**

5.1 Following has to be submitted in separately sealed envelopes Super-scribed as follows:

#### **(i) PRE- QUALIFICATION BID / TECHNICAL BID (ENVELOPE-1)**

Following documents are mandatory & need to be submitted as part of **Technical Bid**, enclosed in Envelope-1; super scribed as "**Technical Bid for Tender of Purchase of Supply, Installation and Commissioning of 500 KVAR Automatic Power Factor Control Panel**".

- Cost of tender form - Rs. 500/- (Rs Five hundred only) and Bid Security (EMD)- Rs. 15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen thousand only) by DD drawn in favour of Sambhar Salts Limited and payable at Sambhar Lake (Rajasthan) OR may be deposited in Company's account through RTGS/ NEFT with declaration as per Annex-A2..
- In case, Bidder is having valid DGS&D rate contract, a copy of which should be enclosed.
- In case, Bidder is registered with NSIC as SSI, a copy of valid certificate should be enclosed for availing exemption for remitting EMD and Cost of Bid Document.
- The firms registered as Micro Small & Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) should enclose a copy of valid registration certificate with Technical bid to avail exemption for remitting EMD & cost of Bid Document.
- General information of the Bidder duly signed by the bidder or his authorized representative in the Performa and format as given in Annex-A3.

- **Original/ downloaded Part-A of the tender document** duly filled, signed and stamped by the bidder or authorized representative of the bidder.
- Declaration as per **Annex-A4** along with attested Copy of Income Tax Return for the last three years, PAN No., GST Registration Certificate of the bidder.
- Documents as proof of successful execution of works as per Eligibility Criteria mentioned at Clause 2 of Part-I, along-with certified copies of the valid Work Order / purchase orders executed.
- Latest/ Valid Authorization from the Principal Company/Manufacturer to the bidder for its brands/products as required.
- Copy of **Financial Statements** and CA certificate indicating a minimum average financial turnover as mentioned clause 2.2 of this part.
- Copies of registration from appropriate authorities under Income Tax Department, GST department etc.
- Technical specification of 500 KVAR APFC Panel and related items along with the detailed drawing of the items and site layout to be submitted along with technical bid.
- Compliance statement in the prescribed format as per Annex-A6 Deviations, if any, in the specifications of the offered equipment's must be brought out clearly with appropriate justification in form of a deviation statement in the same Annexure. If there is any variation from the specifications mentioned in the tender documents and quoted item then list of variations should be enclosed, along with justification of variation & benefit to the company.
- Duly filled Annex-5 and Annex-6.
- In case, Bidder is registered with NSIC as SSI, a copy of certificate should be enclosed and are exempted for remitting EMD and Cost of Bid Document.
- The firms registered as Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) should enclose a copy of registration certificate to avail exemption for remitting EMD & cost of Bid Document.
- MSME status of the bidder. MSME bidders belonging to SC/ST category may also mention their status.
- In case of Start-up, bidder must be recognized by Department of Industrial Policy & Promotion (DIPP) and should submit a copy of valid Registration Certificate along with the technical bid.

**Non-submission of the required documents shall be considered as non-acceptance of terms & conditions of the tender & shall be liable for rejection out rightly.**

5.2 The tender shall be submitted by dropping the Envelope-3 in the tender box placed for the purpose on or before due date of opening of the tender as prescribed in the tender documents.

Non submission of requisite document(s) or providing of incomplete technical details by the bidder is liable to bid rejection during the technical evaluation stage itself without any further reference, whatsoever.

### **5.3 PRICE BID**

5.3.1 The Price Bids must be submitted in the prescribed format as **Annex- B1** and nowhere else in Envelope-2 only.

**5.3.2 PLEASE NOTE THAT NO PRICES SH ALL BE INDIC AT ED IN THE PQB OR THE TECHNICAL BID OTHERWISE, THE BID WILL BE REJECTED OUTRIGHTLY WITHOUT ANY FURTHER CORRESPONDENCE.**

5.3.3 Rates will be fixed till duration of contract and no escalation of prices shall be provided on any account whatsoever.

5.3.4 The rate must be written both in words and figures. There should be no erasures and or over writings. Corrections, if any, should be made clearly and initialled with date. In case if there is variation observed in the rates in between words & figures, the lowest rate shall be considered.

5.3.5 Rates entered in the tender shall unless specifically stated to the contrary shall cover the cost on delivered basis to the consignee on for destination basis and shall include all expenses whatsoever which the bidder may have to incur in connection with the carrying out of the contract/ delivering of material on FOR destination basis, however **All Taxes and duties for shall be paid by company on actual basis as applicable on the date of submission of bill.**

### **6.0 OPENING OF TENDERS**

6.1 Technical Bid of the Tenders will be opened on the mentioned date at the office of General Manager (Works), Sambhar Salts Ltd., Sambhar Lake-303604, Distt. Jaipur (Rajasthan).

6.2 The tender in which any of the prescribed conditions are not fulfilled, is liable to be rejected. Sambhar Salts Limited, reserves the right to accept any tender/or to reject any or all the tenders received, without assigning any reason.

6.3 Price Bid of only Qualified Bidders shall be opened. Date and Time of Opening of Price Bid shall be notified to the qualified bidders.

## **7.0 GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT**

7.1 The Company reserves the right of giving purchase/ price preference to the offers from Public Sector Undertakings in accordance with the policy of Govt. of India from time to time.

7.2 Tender received after due date and time as mentioned in the tender document will not be entertained.

7.3 The firms black listed by any of the Government Department shall not be eligible for submission of bid.

7.4 Tender not submitted in the appropriate prescribed form or not completed in all respects shall be rejected.

7.5 Tenders without requisite EMD and Cost of Tender Form shall be rejected out-rightly.

7.6 Bidder shall not be entitled to claim any costs charged or incidental or in connection with the preparation and submission of their tenders even though Sambhar Salts Limited may choose to withdraw the notification of tender or reject all the Tenders without assigning any reason thereof.

7.7 Company may seek additional information from Bidder/Contractors for completion of Tender Process.

7.8 In case notified date for submission/opening of tenders happens to be holiday than submission /opening of tenders will take place on next working day.

7.9 Successful bidder will submit undertaking to accept Terms and Conditions of the Tender document and to comply with them as per **Annex-A5** on Non-Judicial stamp paper of Rs.500/- duly notarized and signed by the bidder or authorized representative of the bidder.

7.10 On-site or off-site demonstration may be required by the company for evaluation the performance of equipment. Bidder / agency will be arranged the demonstration for technical evaluation at their own cost.

7.11 The provisions of "Micro, Small & Medium Enterprise Development Act, 2006 and the Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 (as amended from time to time), shall be applicable to the MSME & SC/ST MSME registered parties.

## **8.0 VALIDITY OF OFFER:**

The rates should be valid for a period of 90 days, from the date of opening of Technical Bids of tender. If required the bidder shall extend the validity date. No revision/modifications in the tender and rate or the withdrawal of the tender will be allowed during the period of validity of tender or during extended period if any, withdrawal of offer within the stipulated validity period will entitle the Company to forfeit the EMD of the bidder.

## **9.0 AWARD OF CONTRACT:**

9.1 Bidders, who have failed to fulfil earlier contractual obligations, shall not be considered.

9.2 The order or acceptance resulting from this tender and any amendments to be issued subsequently with its terms & conditions and stipulations in response to this tender or revised offer or any counter offer will constitute the entire Agreement relating to the tender between the successful Bidder and the Sambhar Salts Limited and both parties are bound by the terms and conditions as stipulated in the tender documents.

9.3 **The company reserves the right to cancel any or all tenders without assigning any**



reason whatsoever.

**10. SITE VISIT:**

Bidders are requested to visit the site before submission of offers, however cost of site visit shall be in the scope of bidder only.

## **PART-II**

### **DETAILED TENDER NOTICE AND THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE CONTRACT WHICH WILL BE BINDING ON THE PARTIES ON ACCEPTANCE OF THIS TENDER/OFFER OR COUNTER OFFER OR REVISED OFFER ARISING FROM OR INCONSEQUENCE OF THIS TENDER.**

In addition to Part-I (Instruction to Bidders) the following terms and conditions will apply to the contract. The terms and conditions given below even if contrary, to any instructions given in Part-I, shall prevail thereon.

#### **ARTICLE – 1: DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION:-**

Wherever used in this contract and / or in any of the Annexure hereto, unless the context shall otherwise require, the following terms shall have the following meanings.-

- 1.1 “COMPANY”: shall mean “Sambhar Salts Limited”, A Company within the meaning of Companies Act, 1956 having its Registered Office at Hindustan Salts Limited (A Government of India Enterprise), G-229, Sitapura Industrial Area, Jaipur- 302022(Rajasthan) India Capital of Rajasthan State and shall include its lawful successors and assignees.
- 1.2 “BIDDER”: shall mean in the State of \_\_\_\_\_ , shall include its lawful successors and assignees and is responsible to do the work as mentioned in the Article 2 - Scope of work.
- 1.3 “CONTRACT”: shall mean the Terms and Conditions as per the Tender Documents Part-A & Part-B and SUBSEQUENT AMENDMENTS THERETO, if any, agreed in writing by the parties hereto on the basis of which the Bidder shall carry out the work arising out of this tender.
- 1.4 “CONTRACTOR” shall mean successful Bidder who is awarded contract to perform the work covered under this tender document and shall be deemed to include the contractor’s successors, executors and assignees.
- 1.5 “APPROVAL OF COMPANY”: shall mean the written approval of the Chairman & Managing Director of the Company or the person authorized by him.
- 1.6 Words denoting masculine gender or singular number shall also include the feminine gender and plural number and Vice - Versa where the contract so requires or perm its.
- 1.7 “**CONTRACT VALUE**”: shall mean total cost for equipment supplied consequent of finalisation as a result of this tender notice.
- 1.8 “**Defect Liability Period**” means the period of validity of the warranties given by the Contractor commencing at Completion of the Facilities, during which the Contractor is responsible for defects with respect to the Facilities (or the relevant part thereof).

## **ARTICLE 2: SCOPE OF WORK**

- 2.1 The successful bidder shall Design & supply the 500 KVAR APFC Panel Boards, as per the technical specifications. The bidder shall demonstrate the performance of the APFC Panel board at site to the satisfaction of the Company Engineer. The materials should be defect free and of good workmanship. The supplier shall prepare drawings for the equipment and get it approved by Company prior to execution. The supplier shall commission the APFC Panel at site. The required civil work, earthlings, and the cable laying work up to panel board shall be made by the Company under the supervision of the Contractor. The supplier shall demonstrate the function of each components of the panel board at site. The supplier is to submit the single line diagram, cable termination diagram and other related drawings and diagram at site in three copies. One copy is to be submitted with the bill.
- 2.2 **Delivery:** The delivery period is three (3) months from the date of approval of drawings. The drawings must be submitted within fifteen (15) days from the date of issue of PO. Company may negotiate a realistic delivery period with the vendor if the situation warrants so. The supplier shall deliver & installation the materials at the respective site as mentioned by the company.
- 2.3 **Warranty:** The supplier shall extend warranty for thirty six (36) months from the date of installation & commissioning in respect of proper design, quality, workmanship, correctness in dimension for which same are ordered. The supplier shall be liable to replace defective parts or in whole within a maximum period of One (1) month on free of cost. No extra charge for transportation shall be paid to the supplier against such replacement.

## **ARTICLE 3: TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS**

**Bidders are required to submit the Compliance Statement as per Annex.6 regarding the acceptance of technical specifications with technical bid.**

## **ARTICLE - 4: METHOD OF BID EVALUATION**

**Price Bid Evaluation:** - The bid shall be evaluated based on following criteria and points:

- 4.1 The bidder declared PQB & technically responsive shall qualify for Price Bid opening and further process.
- 4.2 The price bid is to be quoted strictly as per the format given in Annex-B1. There should be no cutting or overwriting.
- 4.3 If price bid is not quoted as per the format in Annex-B1, the bid is liable to reject or the purchaser may make its own judgment regarding the price bid quoted by the bidder.
- 4.4 The tender shall be awarded to technically responsive bidder for which Gross Total Payable Amount i.e. row 3 of the price bid is found lowest however decision of the Purchaser / Company shall be final in this regard.

## **ARTICLE 5: ACCEPTANCE OF TENDER AND AWARDING OF CONTRACT**

On acceptance of this tender/ offer or revised offer or counter offer either by the Bidder or by the Sambhar Salts Limited as the case may be the terms and conditions contained in this part will also constitute a contract between the parties i.e. Hindustan Salts Limited, a Company incorporated under the Companies Act, 1956 having its Registered Office at G-229, Sitapura Industrial Area, Jaipur-302022 in the State of Rajasthan, India hereinafter called the "COMPANY" or "Sambhar Salts Limited" which expression shall unless repugnant to the context or of the meaning thereof be deemed to include the Company's Lawful successors, administrators and assignees of the one part.

AND,

M/s \_\_\_\_\_ in the state of \_\_\_\_\_ hereinafter called the "CONTRACTOR" which expression shall unless repugnant to the context or the meaning thereof be deemed to include the Bidder's Lawful successors, administrators and assignees of the other part. The work will be required to be done in accordance with the scope and schedule of work as per tender document.

**ARTICLE 6: TIME SCHEDULE FOR COMPLETION OF CONTRACT**

**ARTICLE 7: PENALTY FOR DELAY IN EXECUTION OF CONTRACT**

- 7.1 The Successful Bidder/ Contractor shall be responsible to execute the contract as per schedule mentioned in the tender documents / work order issued, failing which penalty @ 0.5% per week shall be charged, for the delayed commissioning of APFC Panel Boards, as per the technical specifications subject to maximum 10% of Contract value, after which Company shall without prejudice to exercising SSL's other right as per terms of order, terminate the order wholly or partly as the case may be and get it completed by itself or reassign to other supplier(s) at the risk and cost of Contractor to complete & performance security/ies submitted by the Contractor in this case will be forfeited.

**ARTICLE 8: EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT, SECURITY DEPOSIT & PERFORMANCE SECURITY**

- 8.1 **Earnest Money Deposit:**
- 8.1.1 Bidder should pay requisite earnest money deposit (EMD) either by Demand draft in favour of Sambhar Salts Limited payable at Sambhar Lake or through RTGS/ NEFT. The tender without earnest money shall be out rightly rejected.
- 8.1.2 In case the party fails to take up the work within a specified period after acceptance of their tender, revised offer or counter offer in consequences of this tender notice then the earnest money so deposited will stand forfeited to the company.
- 8.2 **Security Deposit:**

As security for proper and faithful fulfilment of the obligation under the contract, the Contractor will furnish to the company a Security cum performance guarantee **equal to 10% of the Contract Value** by Bank Draft payable to Sambhar Salts Ltd. payable at Sambhar Lake or in the form of a Bank Guarantee in the format provided by company from a Nationalized/Scheduled Bank within fifteen (15) days from the date of receipt of LOI/Order. **The Bank Guarantee should be valid ninety days beyond Warranty Period.**

In case security cum performance guarantee is submitted through Bank Draft the EMD will be adjusted in the same and remaining amount may be deposited by the successful bidder.

In case security cum performance guarantee is submitted through Bank Guarantee then, EMD of the successful bidder will be refunded upon receipt of such Bank Guarantee.

**8.3 Interest will not be allowed on EMD/SD/Performance security:**

Interest will not be allowed on EMD and performance security. In the event of breach of contract on the part of the Bidder/ Successful Bidder the Company will be entitled to forfeit wholly or partially the above amount of Performance Security/ EMD/ SD with the Company. No interest will be allowed on the Performance Security/ EMD/ SD paid in cash/ demand draft/ any other mode of transfer. The Company further reserves the right to adjust the Performance Security Deposit towards any amount due to the Company from the Contractor and in such event, the Contractor on receipt of notice from the Company, shall make further deposit to restore the Security Deposit to the full amount.

**8.4 Refund of Security Deposit:**

Security Deposit shall be refunded after **ninety (90) days** of completion of defect liability period and receipt of "No Demand/ No Dues" certificate from the General Manager (Works),SSL regarding **satisfactory completion of contract.**

**8.5 With-holding or forfeiture of Performance Security Deposit/ Security Deposit:**

Without prejudice to the rights of the company to claim damages arising on account of breach of contract under the Contract Act, 1972 the Performance Security Deposit shall be liable to be withheld/ forfeited wholly or partially at the sole discretion of the Company when the Bidder either fail to fulfil his contractual obligations or to settle in full his dues to the company.

**8.6 Recovery from Performance Security Deposit/ EMD/ SD:** The company is empowered to deduct from the Performance Security Deposit/ EMD/ Security Deposit or from any other outstanding amount, any sum that may be fixed by the company as being the amount of loss or losses or damages suffered by it due to delay in performance or non-performance of any of the conditions of the contract.

**ARTICLE 9: PAYMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

9.1 70% payment shall be released after delivery of materials at site with due inspection by the representative of the company and on submission of the bill in duplicate along with test certificate.

9.2 20% payment shall be released after commissioning of the APFC Panel at site.

9.3 Balance 10% along with EMD shall be released after completion of warranty period of 36 months. If the agency wants to take the balance 10% value before the warranty period then the agency is required to submit PBG of equivalent amount valid till completion of warranty period, in company format, on any Nationalized Bank.

**Note:** All payments shall only be made after verification by the authorised officer of the

company.

**Freight & Insurance:** Transportation and transit insurance charges, if any, shall be borne by the Supplier.

**LIQUIDATED DAMAGE CLAUSE /PENALTY:** In case the supplier fails to deliver within the period agreed and stipulated in the purchase order, the penalty will be 0.25% of the basic order value for each 1/10<sup>th</sup> delay of the original delivery period calculated in number of days. However penalty on this account will not exceed 5% of the basic order value. If the order is not executed within twice the duration of the agreed delivery period then it will be at the discretion of the company management to cancel the PO./Contract with forfeiture of EMD.

However, company shall review the evolving work requirement for the accomplishment of order by the vendor and if required, may extend the time period.

15. **Price fall clause:** In the event of the supplier found accepting lower prices or supplying at lower rates prior to and after finalisation of rates to any other organization, the said lower rates shall be made applicable to company against the PO.
16. **Test Certificate:-**The supplier shall submit the test certificate wherever required by Company.

#### **ARTICLE 10: DIFFERENCES OR DISPUTES**

##### 10.1 **Mutual Settlement of Disputes**

10.1.1 Except where otherwise provided for in the contract, all disputes shall in the first place be resolved through mutual discussions, negotiations, deliberations and consultations associating senior executives/ nominees of both the parties to dispute.

##### 10.2 **Conciliation**

10.2.1 If the efforts to resolve all or any of the disputes through mutual settlement fail, such disputes shall be referred to the sole conciliator to be appointed by the Company under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.

10.2.2 The settlement agreement shall be final and binding on the parties. The settlement agreement shall have status and effect of an arbitration award.

##### 10.3 **Arbitration**

10.3.1 If the efforts to resolve all or any of the disputes through conciliation fail, such disputes shall be referred to the sole Arbitrator to be appointed by the Chairman cum Managing Director, Hindustan/Sambhar Salts Limited. There shall be no objection by the "CONTRACTOR" if the sole Arbitrator so appointed is an employee of Company. In case the Arbitrator so appointed is unable to act for any reason, Chairman & Managing Director, Hindustan/Sambhar Salts Limited, in the event of such inability, shall appoint another person to act as an Arbitrator in accordance with the terms of the contract. Such persons shall be entitled to proceed with reference from the stages at which it was left incomplete by his predecessor.

10.3.2 Subject to the afore stated conditions, the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 or any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof and the rules made there under and for the time being in force shall apply to the conciliation and arbitration proceedings under this clause.

- 10.4 Pending resolution of disputes and differences, the work shall continue without hindrance as per schedule and shall not be either slowed down or stopped. If the work is slowed down or stopped during the period of dispute, the "CONTRACTOR" shall be responsible for the loss of work /production or delays and any loss sustained by Company due to such actions by the "CONTRACTOR", shall be made good by the "CONTRACTOR".
- 10.5 The Arbitrator may from time to time, with the consent of all parties, extend the time in making the award.
- 10.6 The cost incidental to the arbitration shall be at the discretion of the Arbitrator. The arbitration shall be conducted at Jaipur (Rajasthan) or at such other place or places as the Arbitrator may so decide.
- 10.7 The provisions of "Micro, Small & Medium Enterprise Development Act, 2006 and the Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 (as amended from time to time), shall be applicable to the parties.

#### **ARTICLE 11: JURISDICTION**

Subject to Article 10 above, it is hereby agreed that all actions at law or suits arising out of or in connection with this contract or the subject matter thereof whether as to construction or otherwise shall be instituted in court of competent jurisdiction at Jaipur in the State of Rajasthan, India.

#### **ARTICLE 12: FORCE MAJEURE**

In case either of parties fail, to fulfil, in time, then, respective contractual obligation owing to future event beyond their control like Acts of God (including fire, flood, earthquake, storm, hurricane or other natural disaster), war, invasion, act of foreign enemies, hostilities, civil war, rebellion, from time to time for performance of such obligation/ responsibility shall automatically extended for the period of force majeure. Provided force majeure is established & one party shall inform to the other party for such occurrence but no one party shall blame other party and claim by the Bidder due to force majeure condition & both parties mutually agree to further course of action.

#### **ARTICLE 13: RECESSION AND CANCELLATION OF CONTRACT**

- 13.1 If any technical or legal complication arises through statutory agencies or any other reason, during the period of contract, then contract shall be terminated by the company at its discretion by giving 7 days' notice to the Contractor and Contractor shall not claim any damages for such cancellation of contract.

#### **13.2 Risk & Cost Clause:**

Without prejudice to the rights of the company and notwithstanding the obligations of the Contractor under the contract arising from the acceptance of this tender or the revise offer or counter offer in response to this tender or in consequences of this tender in the event of any failure on the part of the Contractor, the Company will be free to get the same executed in any manner at the risk and cost of the Contractor and the additional burden on this account, if any, will be borne by the Contractor, and can be realized from the Bidder's pending bills/ Security money deposit or any other dues. This is without prejudice to the Company's claim for other losses and damages that may arise due to the failure of the Contractor to keep upto the terms of the contract.

#### **ARTICLE 14: NONE SUBLETTING OF CONTRACT**

The Contractor is barred from any sub-letting of contract of any nature.

## **ARTICLE 15: DAMAGES UNDER THE CONTRACT**

### **Loss or Damage to Company's Property:**

The Contractor shall carry out the work without damage and/or interference to any other work, machines or equipment and property of the company or other contractors of company in area, adjacent to the area of Contractor's work.

In case during the execution of contract by the bidder any loss or damage occurs to any property of Sambhar Salts Limited, then contract shall be terminated by the company and the amount deposited by the party shall be forfeited. For damaging the company property Civil and Criminal proceedings will be initiated against the Bidder at the discretion of company and loss incurred by the company due to such damages will be recovered from the bidder.

## **ARTICLE -16: POWER OF ATTORNEY**

A person signing the agreement or any documents forming part of the contract on behalf of the bidder shall be responsible to produce a proper power of attorney duly executed and attested by a Notary public under the Notaries Act in his favour stating that he had authority to bind the Bidder in all matters pertaining to the contract including the arbitration clause.

## **ARTICLE 17: CHANGE IN CONSTITUTION**

On the death or retirement of any partner of the successful bidder/ Contractor before complete performance of the contract, the Sambhar Salts Limited may at his option cancel the contract and in such case the Contractor shall have no claim whatsoever to be compensated by Sambhar Salts Limited without prejudice to any of rights or remedies under this contract.   - (b) If any decrease takes place in taxes and duties etc., due to statutory variation, the same shall be passed on to SSL or SSL shall admit the decreased rate of taxes and duties while making the payment.
