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TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS & SCOPE OF WORK

The Company invites bid for Repairing of boiler Capacity-2 Tonnes Per Hour, at Hindustan Salts Limited, Kharaghoda- Gujarat as per specifications and specified number given in the tender document.

A. TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS for work of Repair/replacement of fire tubes(126 nos.) for Package Boiler Make – Real Boiler. Capacity-2 TPH.:

1	Supply of required certified tubes, inspection/permission from Authority Replacement of all corroded/Thinned and leaky smoke tubes of boiler including the cutting, removing, ramming, grinding, expanding and welding of tubes as per IBR. Total nos. of tubes to be replaced (126 nos.), followed by necessary cleaning and hydraulic test to get it approved from the concern authority(Rajkot) as per IBR. B. Detailed Scope of Work : All repair work in-pressure part should have the approval of the concerned (Indian Boiler Regulation) statutory authorities. After the approval, pressure part repair/replace work has to undertake only with qualified welder/agency as per Indian Boiler Regulation (IBR) norms. Agency require to confirm the material of construction ,tube size and edge preparation etc. before start of the repair/replacement work. The contractor shall carry out following repair work to boiler with certification as follows:

1. Contractor will make all the drawings required for the fabrication of the tube replacement, repair or replacement of parts as per requirement and get all the drawings approved from Authority ,Gujarat. Approval of all work & Certification from Concern Competent Authority Gujarat will be in party scope.

DRAWINGS: As appropriate, drawings shall be prepared to describe the repair. Drawings shall include sufficient information to satisfactorily perform the repair. Following review and certification, the repair plan shall be submitted for acceptance to the Authorized Inspection Agency as per IBR, Gujarat and make the acceptance inspection and sign.

2. Replacement of all corroded/Thinned and leaky smoke tubes of boiler including the cutting, removing, ramming, grinding, expanding and welding of tubes as per IBR.

- 2.1. Supply of carbon steel tube Specification's BS3059 Part I ERW 320, IBR Certified, and to be fitted under the following specification.(total tubes -126 nos.)

66 nos.- 63.50mm (OD) X3.66mm (Thick) X 3.22 (+/-1%)Meter length

66 nos.- 63.50mm (OD)X3.66mm (Thick) X 2.46 (+/-1%)Meter length

- 2.2. Drilling of boiler plate by only manual clamping and cutter method is used for removing old welding of boiler tube.



- 2.3. Welding, grinding, ramming of all oval shape tube holes.
- 2.4. Cleaning of tubes ends to bright metal, inside and outside for at least 40mm from weld area and removing of all deposits of oxide, boiler water salts and slugs to avoid gas and slag inclusions in the weld.
- 2.5. Cutting of new tubes in proper size and annealing of both end of tube. (Important: projection of tube from tube sheet is max. 3.5mm)
- 2.6. Fitting, expanding of both ends of tube in boiler plate.
- 2.7. Tubes should be butt welded by fusion welding and these tested hydraulically at discretion of the Boiler Inspector.
- 2.8. Tubes to be seal welded provided the ends of the tubes have sufficient wall thickness to prevent burn through. Seal welding shall be applied with a maximum of three light layers in lieu of one or two heavy layers. Seal welding shall not be considered a strength weld.
- 2.9. During fabrication of the tubes, contractor will arrange the inspection of the tubes by the concern authority, Gujarat before fitting, if required, as per standard norms of IBR.
- 2.10. Contractor shall carry-out all the allied jobs related to the re-tubing of the boiler, like chemical cleaning & hydro test etc.
- 2.11. Unit of Measurement (UOM) = no. of tubes basis.
Total length of tube fitted (in meter) on actual basis.
Approximation of length are as follows :-
66 nos.- 63.50mm (OD) X3.66mm (Thick) X 3.22 (+/-1%)Meter length
66 nos.- 63.50mm (OD)X3.66mm (Thick) X 2.46 (+/-1%)Meter length
3. Chemical & mechanical Cleaning of boiler: method of removing hydroxyl apatite and other phosphate scales from boilers, and other equipment, as per standard procedure prescribed by IBR.
4. All repair work shall be carried out under the guidance of Boiler Inspector as per practice of IBR to satisfy the Boiler Inspector.
5. The electric arc or oxy-acetylene gas welding sets and all other tools in contractor possession for carrying out repair/replace the tubes must suitable for the work undertaken.
6. All tools –tackles and consumable items unless specifically like DC welding set (Rectifier) with adequate cable length suitable for working in boiler, electrode, DA & Oxygen etc. are in contractor scope.
7. The quality of material used conforms to the specifications that are prescribed by IBR.
8. Welders employed by him possess certificate issued as required by IBR.
9. After the finished repair weld has cooled to ambient temperature, the final temper bead reinforcement layer shall be removed substantially flush with the surface of the base material.



10. Standard of work should be of high order and comply with all the requirements and test may prescribed by Boiler Inspector as per IBR.
11. Disposal off site of all components removed in accordance with environmental standards and clean-up of the site during and after the work.
12. **Utility supply by HSL (Power, Water, only)**
Responsibility of HSL will be of providing 3 phase /single phase power at one point. The contractor has to make his own arrangement to use the same at work site by extending cables etc. as per requirement.
13. If required and as well as if available, welding machines and other required material may be provided by HSL at site for fast working but all consumables shall be in the scope of the contractor.
14. **Transportation, handling and storage of materials and tools/machines etc:** Bidder will have to arrange for the transportation (including loading & unloading), handling and storage of all tools, tackles,
15. **COMPLETION SCHEDULE:** Contractor must complete all above task within 25 days strictly with effective from date of issuance of Letter of Award.
16. **DEFECT LIABILITY PERIOD:** The contractor has to stand guarantee for the work executed done by him against bad workmanship for a period of **six (6) months** from the date of completion of job. If any defect or damages are noticed as a result of poor workmanship during the defect liability period, the same has to be rectified by the contractor free of cost.
17. Official fee for annual passing /certification from authority as per IBR shall be in the scope of Hindustan Salts Ltd..
18. Contractor may visit at site Kharaghoda before participating in bidding to ensure the exact dimension /status of job to be completed.
19. Any other repairing (apart of replacing of tube)inside shell and outside shell required to be carried out as per IBR shall be treated separately.
20. **SAFETY OF PERSONNEL**
 - a) The contractor shall cover all personnel deputed for work under appropriate insurance scheme.
 - b) The company shall not be responsible or held responsible or held liable for any damage to person or property that may result during the execution of contract by the contractor.
 - c) The contractor has to agree to indemnify the company from any or all claims/losses for damages that may result during the execution of Contract by the contractor.
 - d) Contractor will take full safety measures and arrange the necessary safety gadgets/appliances, tools and tackles, helmet, gumboot, safety belt, goggles, gloves, apron, ladders, bamboos, ropes, machineries, etc. required for the work by their own so as to ensure that no damage, loss or injury to Company's personnel, contractor's personnel, third party or equipment are caused due to the work being carried out by contractor.



- e) The contractor shall provide all safety gears and livery (such as helmet, safety shoes, hand gloves, safety belts etc.) to its workmen to ensure their safety and protection from injuries during the execution of works.
- f) The bidder shall not claim against any loss in respect of the workers deployed for work.
21. Any statutory payments/remittances like EPF contribution etc., in respect of the workers shall be the sole responsibility of the contractor.
22. If the bidder shall have any doubt as to the meaning of any portion of the general conditions or the special conditions or the size and scope of the work or the specifications and drawings or any other matter concerning the contract he shall in good time, before submitting tender, put forth the particulars thereof and submit them to company in writing in order that such doubts may be clarified authoritatively in writing before tendering. Once a tender is submitted the matter will be decided according to tender conditions in the absence of such authentic pre-clarification.
23. The bidder shall keep confidential all the information relating to work or to any other aspect of Company's business that comes into his possession as a result of or in connection with this work.

Each of this instruction must be read carefully and followed strictly. Failure in complying with any of these would render your offer liable for rejection.

1. The offer should be in sealed envelope and preferably be sent by Registered Post/Speed Post/Dropping of offer in Tender Box placed in the office of General Manager(Works), Hindustan Salts Limited, Kharaghoda-382760, Distt. Surendra Nagar, Gujarat. Intending bidders are advised to post their offers well in the time so as to reach us before bid due date and time. Offers received after the due date and time of submission of bids shall not be entertained.
2. The Enquiry No., Bid Due Date, Name & Address of Party and details of EMD should be super scribed on the envelope, failing which the offer may be rejected.
3. The firms registered as Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) should enclose a copy of valid registration certificate with bid to avail exemption for remitting EMD. The provisions of "Micro, Small & Medium Enterprise Development Act, 2006 and the Micro and Small Enterprises (MSE's) Order, 2012 (as amended from time to time), shall be applicable.
4. The quoted price must be written in both figures and words in capital letters, alterations if any, should be made clearly be crossing the whole entered rate and last corrections should be attested by the tenderer with their full signature and rubber stamp. In no case there should be overwriting and all tenders with such overwriting shall be liable for rejection. In case of any discrepancy between figures and words the lowest rates shall be considered for purpose of evolution.
5. HSL reserves the right to accept or reject any/all offers without assigning any reason thereof to increase/decrease the work. The quoted rates, terms and conditions shall apply.
6. **Schedule for Completion of Work** : Contractor must complete all above task within 25 days strictly with effective from date of issuance of Letter of Award.
7. **Contract Value** : Value of Work Inclusive of Applicable Taxes finalised as a result of this tender
8. **Terms of payment: The payment shall be released as below:**
- 8.1 **30 % of total value including GST shall be paid against receiving ,inspection and approval of total tubes from authority at site.**
- 8.2 **Remaining 70% after successful completion of job followed by annual clearance /passing from the concern authority as per IBR and successful trial run for desired result.**
9. Documents to be submitted by bidder with the Bid :

 - c) Documents in support of Eligibility criteria as mentioned in Annex.I

- 9.1 Company may ask for submission of requisite supporting documents from Bidders while evaluating Technical /Commercial Bids.



10. Tenderers shall certify that the quoted rates are as applicable to Govt. Department/Public Sector Undertakings.
11. **Penalty** : The Successful Bidder/ Contractor shall be responsible to execute the contract as per schedule mentioned in the tender documents / work order issued, failing which penalty @ 0.5% per week shall be charged, for the delayed work subject to maximum 10% of Contract value, after which Company shall without prejudice to exercising HSL's other right as per terms of order, terminate the order wholly or partly as the case may be and get it completed by itself or reassign to other supplier(s) at the risk and cost of Contractor to complete & Security Deposit submitted by the Contractor in this case will be forfeited.
12. **Security Deposit:**
- Security Deposit @ 5% of contract value is to be remitted by contractor on awarding of contract and Earnest Money so deposited shall be adjusted in security deposit. and shall be kept with the company for the successful completion of contract. Security deposit can be submitted by NEFT /RTGS/DD/FDR/Bank Guarantee.
 - Interest will not be allowed on EMD/SD
 - Refund of Security Deposit: On satisfactory performance of the contract and on receipt of "No Demand/ New Dues" certificate from the General Manager (Works), the Security Deposit will be refunded to the Contractor provided that no claim whatsoever against the Contractor is made and nothing is due from the Contractor and that the Contractor has completed the work to the entire satisfaction of the Company.
13. The quoted rates must be firm till the complete execution of the contract and must be valid for a period of 90 days from the date of opening of the tender for placement of order.
14. Bidders may note that the due date and time of opening of tenders will be strictly adhered to and accordingly if they wish to present themselves in the tender opening, they should bring necessary authorisation letter from the company. However, due to declaration of unexpected holiday or any unforeseen circumstances the tenders are not opened on the due date, the same will be opened on the next working day.
15. Bidders should note that printed terms and conditions shall not be considered for evaluation purposes unless otherwise specifically mentioned in the offer itself.
16. All actions under law or suits arising out of or in connection with this contract or the subjected matter thereof whether as to construction or otherwise shall be instituted in court of competent jurisdiction at Jaipur in the State of Rajasthan, India.
17. **Risk & Cost Clause:** Without prejudice to the rights of the company and notwithstanding the obligations of the Contractor under the contract arising from the acceptance of this tender or the revise offer or counter offer in response to this tender or in consequences of this tender in the event of any failure on the part of the Contractor, the Company will be free to get the same executed in any manner at the risk and cost of the Contractor and the additional burden on this account, if any, will be borne by the Contractor, and can be realized from the Bidder's pending bills/ Security money deposit or any other dues. This is without prejudice to the Company's claim for other losses and damages that may arise due to the failure of the Contractor to keep upto the terms of the contract.
18. **Damages Under The Contract:**
Loss or Damage to Company's Property:
- The Contractor shall carry out the work without damage and/or interference to any other work, machines or equipment and property of the company or other contractors of company in area, adjacent to the area of Contractor's work.
 - In case during the execution of contract by the bidder any loss or damage occurs to any property of Hindustan Salts Limited, then contract shall be terminated by the company and the amount deposited by the party shall be forfeited. For damaging the company property Civil and Criminal proceedings will be initiated against the Bidder at the discretion of company and loss incurred by the company due to such damages will be recovered from the bidder.
19. **Force Majeure:** In case either of parties fail, to full fill, in time, then, respective contractual obligation owing to future event beyond their control like Acts of God (including fire, flood, earthquake, storm, hurricane or other natural disaster), war, invasion, act of foreign enemies, hostilities, civil war, rebellion, from time to time for performance of such obligation/responsibility shall automatically extended for the period of force majeure. Provided force majeure is established & one party shall inform to the other party for such occurrence but no one party shall blame other party and claim by the Bidder due to force majeure condition, & both parties mutually agree to further course of action.



20. **Notices:** Any notice hereunder may be served on the Bidder/Contractor by registered mail at his last known address. Proof of issue of any such notice will be conclusive of the Bidder/Contractor having been duly informed.
21. **Canvassing is Prohibited**
- Canvassing in connection with the tender is strictly prohibited and tender is liable to be rejected.
 - Any bribe or commission, gift or favours given, promised or offered by or on behalf of the Bidders/Contractor, their partners, agents or servants to any officers, servant or representative of the Hindustan Salts Limited for obtaining or for the execution of this or any other contract or for receiving payments under the contract shall in addition to the criminal liability may ensure cancellation of this tender or any other Contracts and also to payment of any loss resulting from any such cancellation. Hindustan Salts Limited shall be entitled to deduct the amount so payable from any money otherwise due to the Contractor under this or any other Contracts. Any question or disputes as to whether the Contractor s have incurred any liability under this clause shall be settled by Hindustan Salts Limited in such manner and on such evidence or information as it may think fit and sufficient and its decision shall be final and binding.
22. **Maintenance of Discipline by the Contractor:** The Contractor shall be liable to comply with covenants of contract and tender documents. The company expected the Contractor and his representatives and the labour to conduct themselves in a disciplined manner. All rules and instructions pertaining to well-being of the factory and its precincts, the sanitation and health etc. should be adhered to and in the event of any theft, arson or any antisocial activities on the part of the Contractor, his employees or his labour, the company shall have the right to terminate the' agreement.
23. **Governing Laws and Right of Indemnity of the Company:** The Contractor shall indemnify the company for all the injuries caused to any person or to public property due to his negligence or to the negligence of his workmen during the performance of contract.
- Contractor shall abide by all existing / future labour enactments and rules, regulations, notifications and bye laws of State or Central Government or local authority.
 - The Contractor shall comply with all the provisions of the Statutory Acts and rules framed here under particularly in respect of the Factory Act. 1948, the Payment of Wages Act 1936, the Industrial Disputes Act,1947, the Industrial Employment Standing Orders Act,1946, the Minimum Wages Act,1948, the Collection of Statistic Act,1953, the Workmen's Compensation Act, 1923, Fatal Accidents Act, 1935, Personal Injuries (Compensation Insurance) Act, 1963, the Trade union Act, 1926, Maternity Benefit Act, 1961, Employees Provident Fund Act,1952, Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act, 1970, Indian contract Act, 1872 and the rules framed by the state in respect of various Labour Acts as demanded from time to time and shall also comply with the provision of any other enactment statues, rules regulations made by a competent authority and enforced in the state during the currency of the contract. The Contractor shall indemnify the company for the penalties on account of breach of any of the conditions, there under.
 - The company shall remain indemnified by the Bidder against any claim arising under the payment of Wages Act, or the payment of Bonus, C.P. Fund or Gratuity of Compensation Act arising during the pendency of the contract.
 - All such claims will be met with by the Contractor themselves from the payment made to them.
24. **Negotiation :** Normally negotiation of rate shall not be done, if required negotiation of rate can be done with L-1 bidder .The proprietor / partner of the bidder shall either be present personally or depute their senior executive capable of taking spot decision.
25. **Differences Or Disputes:**
- Mutual Settlement of Disputes: Except where otherwise provided for in the contract, all disputes shall in the first place be resolved through mutual discussions, negotiations, deliberations and consultations associating senior executives /nominees of both the parties to dispute.
 - Conciliation :
 - If the efforts to resolve all or any of the disputes through mutual settlement fail, such disputes shall be referred to the sole conciliator to be appointed by the Company under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.
 - The settlement agreement shall be final and binding on the parties. The settlement agreement shall have the same status and effect of an arbitration award.



c. Arbitration:

- i. If the efforts to resolve all or any of the disputes through conciliation fail, such disputes shall be referred to the sole Arbitrator to be appointed by the Chairman cum Managing Director, Hindustan Salts Limited. There shall be no objection by the "CONTRACTOR" if the sole Arbitrator so appointed is an employee of Company. In case the Arbitrator so appointed is unable to act for any reason, Chairman & Managing Director, Hindustan Salts Limited, in the event of such inability, shall appoint another person to act as an Arbitrator in accordance with the terms of the contract. Such persons shall be entitled to proceed with reference from the stages at which it was left incomplete by his predecessor.
- ii. Subject to the afore stated conditions, the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 or any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof and the rules made there under and for the time being in force shall apply to the conciliation and arbitration proceedings under this clause.
- iii. Pending resolution of disputes and differences, the work shall continue without hindrance as per schedule and shall not be either slowed down or stopped. If the work is slowed down or stopped during the period of dispute, the "CONTRACTOR" shall be responsible for the loss of work /production or delays and any loss sustained by Company due to such actions by the "CONTRACTOR", shall be made good by the CONTRACTOR".
- iv. The Arbitrator may from time to time, with the consent of all parties, extend the time in making the award.
- v. The cost incidental to the arbitration shall be at the discretion of the Arbitrator. The arbitration shall be conducted at Jaipur (Rajasthan) or at such other place or places as the Arbitrator may so decide.
